**HUGE, HUGE, HUGE -- QUILTING & SEWING GARGAGE SALE**

Former MLQ member, Diane Harman-Hoog is selling the last of her store inventory and personal stash. Here is of sampling of what's for sale: hundreds of Sulky Threads 10 for \$5. Other assorted threads. Hundreds of yards and fat quarters of fabric (FQs 2 for \$1). Fabric may be sold by weight or \$1-2 per estimated yard. Sewing notions at dirt bottom prices, sewing machine needles, safety pins, silk pins, hand sewing needles, bias bars, foils, inking accessories, Tsunikeo inks, fabric pens, and much more. Storage units for threads and accessories, dozens of packaged patterns \$2 each. Treadle machine in need of work. Everything must go!

Directions: 405 to 520 (towards Redmond). As 520 ends, exit Redmond Way (Hwy 202). At the end of the offramp, turn right on Redmond Way, which will become Hwy 202 (Redmond-Fall City Rd). Continue for 6 miles. Turn left at Ames Lake Road. Proceed 1.6 miles and turn left into Heather Knoll (275th Way NE). Continue on 275th Way NE and as it curves to the left it becomes 273rd. ## Board Meeting Minutes - August 24, 2009

Present: President Ginger Seitz; Secretary Diane Cooper; Treasurer Barbara Burke; Newsletter Marian Martin. Other members present: Carol Peters and Alice Rhodes

Meeting called to order at 6:32 PM by President who had the following for discussion:

- 1) There will be a yes/no ballot vote among MLQ members regarding participation in a quilt and garden tour in 2011. This will be at the September general meeting.
- 2) Round robin/row quilts - Barbara offered to start an "interest" sheet at the next general meeting and, if there are enough members interested, will coordinate the actual activity.
- 3) Krista Moser will be our September speaker with a trunk show of quilts. She will also bring her purses. A link to her website will be in the September newsletter if members are interested in purchases.
- 4) The educational event Sept. 26 is Vicki Hesseltine's sewing machine apron; cost TBA.
- 5) The educational event Oct. 24 is Roxanne Carter's machine quilting with a limit of 25 attending and cost TBA.
- 6) The Scholarship part of our guild needs to be discussed at the Sept. general meeting to decide what it will be for and what committee needs to be formed to handle scholarship.
- 7) There is a day retreat in Mount Vernon on Friday Sept. 18.

Secretary: There were no minutes taken at the picnic. About 25 members attended and we wish to thank Marian Martin for hosting so well.

Treasurer: \$42.50 was made from member sales at the picnic.

Newsletter: August 29 is the deadline for newsletter items and reports.

Alice: 1) CDs of the 2009 MGQT, which were previewed at the picnic, are \$5 each, with proceeds going to MGQT.

2) Charity quilts will start up again in October; current charity quilts will be distributed to Snohomish County Senior Services before the September general meeting.

3) There is agreement that any organization or "home" needs to be personally visited by at least one member to determine eligibility for guild charity quilts.

4) There is a Mukilteo Art Guild Holiday Art Mart at Rosehill Center, Mukilteo, Sat. Nov. 14. For \$55 a space can be rented in which members of the guild can sell their own quilts, with 10% of the proceeds to return to the guild. Members who wish to sell would have to help "person" the booth for the day. The board voted to support this endeavor, approved \$55 to be used out of guild funds, and asked that Alice fill out the application.

Carol: 1) MGQT proceeds for each group may be close to \$4000. There is an interest in putting part of this back into the community soon in the form of a monetary contribution to some local charitable organization.

2) The guild also needs to consider retaining a portion of our proceeds for the next tour as the city may very well not supply grant money so generously, if at all.

Meeting adjourned at 8:15.
